A wheel has been the symbol of Rotary since our earliest days. The first design was made by Chicago Rotarian Montague Bear, an engraver who drew a simple wagon wheel, with a few lines to show dust and motion. The wheel was said to illustrate "Civilization and Movement." Most of the early clubs had some form of wagon wheel on their publications and letterheads. Finally, in 1992, it was decided that all Rotary clubs should adopt a single design as the exclusive emblem of Rotarians. Thus, in 1923, the present gear wheel with 24 cogs and six spokes was adopted by the "Rotary International Association." A group of engineers advised that the gear wheel was mechanically unsound and would not work without a "Keyway" in the center of the gear to attach it to a power shaft. So, in 1923 the Keyway was added and the design which we know was formally adopted was the official Rotary International emblem.

THE FOUR FOUNDING FATHERS OF ROTARY



The First four Rotarians: (left to right) Gustavus loehr, Silvester Schiele, Hiram Shorey, and Paul Harris- Rotary's Founder

Paul P. Harris (1868-1947) Was a Chicago attorney in 1905 when he had an idea for a club in which professionals and businessmen could share "mutual cooperation and informal friendship such as all had once known in our villages." On the evening of Thursday, 23 February 1905, Paul Harris gathered three business acquaintances to form a group that became the Rotary Club of Chicago, initiating the world's first service organization. Though Paul Harris was the visionary of such a club, he voluntarily did not become its head but later on the people under the banner of the organiztion made him the first President of What later named as Rotary International, the association of Rotary clubs around the world with more than 1.2 million members united under the motto "Service Above Self".

Silvester Schiele (1868-1945) was a coal dealer and a client of Paul Harris in 1905. Born in rural Indiana, Schiele liked to tell harris interesting anecdotes of his "young pioneer" boyhood. During the course of their business dealings, Harris first shared the idea with schiele for a new kind of club for professionals. On 23 February 1905, Harris invited Schiele for dinner to develop his ideas of a fellowship and booster club. In addition to becoming first president of the Rotary Club of Chicago, Schiele developed a close lifelong friendship with Harris.

Gustavus H. "Gus" Loehr (1964-1918) was a Chicago mining engineer who lent his office on the seventh floor of the Unity building at 127 Dearborn Street in Chicago for the first gathering of the founders of Ritary on 23 February 1905. Loehr invited Hiram Shorey to this meeting. His health later deteriorated and he left the club, but remained a supporter of Rotary until his death at the age of 53.

Hiram E. Shorey (1862-1944) was merchant tailor in 1905. One of the founding four members of the Rotary Club of Chicago, he remained a Rotarian for only a short time before moving back to his home state of maine. Upon his later return to Chicago, he rejoined for a brief membership, Shorey was always supportive of the Rotary Club of Chicago and voiced pride at his early association with Rotary.

THE VISION OF THE ROTARY FOUNDATION



ARCH C KLUMPH RI President 1917-1918

Arch C. Klumph, the sixth President of Rotary International (1916-17) had a great vision of the future of Rotary as a "movement for the centures." but he realized that it would thrive only if it could sustain itself. It was at the Atlanta Convention in 1917 that he reiterated his plea for "an endowment fund for Rotary for the purpose of doing good to the world" and created The Rotary Foundation (TRF). The first steps in the Foundation's long march were feeble and there were doubts about its future during the depression years of the 1930s and World War II.

What triggered the infusion of life into the TRF was the desire of Rotarians to do something in memory of Rotary's founder, Paul P Harris, following his death in 1947. They started making contributions as paul Harris Fellows (PHFS), paul Harris Sustaining Members (PHSMs) and subsequently remained as Rotary Foundation Sustaining Member (RFSM). It was not long before TRF gained vigour and a firm footing primarily through Rotarians contributions and, later on, donations from other like-minded organizations.

The Foundation's permanent fund is so invested and managed as to yield substantial income to bear its administrative and fundraising costs as well as the surging cost of its numerous programs, which have steadily expanded over the years.

The man who foresaw the role of the TRF in Rotary's future, Arch C. Klumph, was a man of extraordinary energy whose devotion to the cause of Rotary was unparallel. Rising from boyhood poverty to outstanding success as a businessman in Cleveland Ohio, USA, Arch C. Klumph was also an active civic leader, accomplished flutist (he was a member of the Cleveland Symphony Orchestra for 14 years) and sportsman. He was Chirman of the Committee entrusted to write a new constitution for Rotary International and also wrote the Standard Constitution and Bylaws for all Rotary Clubs, adopted in 1915. His work provided the cohesive unity necessary for Rotary's growth.

Arch C Klumph died in 1952, by which time the Rotary Foundation's future was assured and it was "doing good to the world" just as Klumph had envisioned.







RI PRESIDENT 2023-24 R. Gordon R. McInally

R. Gordon R. McInally was educated at the Royal High School in Edinburgh and at the University of Dundee, where he earned his graduate degree in dental surgery. He operated his own dental practice in Edinburgh until 2016. McInally was chair of the East of Scotland branch of the British Paedodontic Society and has held various academic positions. He has also served as a presbytery elder, chair of the Queensferry parish congregational board, and commissioner to the general assembly of the Church of Scotland.

Gordon joined Rotary in 1984 at age 26. A member of the Rotary Club of South Queensferry, he has served as president and vice president of Rotary International in Great Britain and Ireland. He has also served RI as a director and on several committees, most recently as an adviser to the 2022 Houston Convention Committee and chair of the Operations Review Committee.

Gordon says he looks forward to working with

members to build new Rotary clubs and groups. "My vision is that Rotary should exist everywhere in a style to suit everyone who has the desire to be part of us and to help us do good in the world," he says.

He is a patron of the UK-based nonprofit Hope and Homes for Children and led a partnership between that organization and RIBI to support children in Rwanda who had been orphaned in the genocide there. He is a patron of Trade-Aid, an initiative of the Rotary Club of Grantham Kesteven, England, that provides sustainable humanitarian aid to individuals, families, and businesses in the developing world. He is also an ambassador for Bipolar UK, a national mental health organization. In August 2022, he was made a laureate of the Sino Phil Asia International Peace Awards Foundation.

In his free time, Gordon enjoys rugby, good food and wine, and stick dressing, the traditional Scottish craft of making walking sticks.

Gordon describes The Rotary Foundation as "the engine that provides the energy to do Rotary service." He and his spouse, Heather, also a Rotarian, are Paul Harris Fellows, Major Donors, Benefactors of The Rotary Foundation, and members of the Bequest Society.

Gordon wishes to dedicate his presidency to making the world a better place for his granddaughters, Ivy and Florence, and all the children of the world, to live and thrive.

Dr. Mohammed Farashuddin is the Chief Adviser and Founder Vice-Chancellor of East West University; Former Chairman, Planning Commission Reorganizing Committee: Member, Governing Council and Academic Council, Dhaka School of Economics, Visiting Professor, Institute of Business Administration, University of Dhaka; Member, Executive Council of South Asian University; Former Member of the International Civil Service Commission (ICSC) of the United Nations.

He was the Chairman, Pay and Service Commission-2013; Chairman, Governing Body, Dhaka City College; Governor, Bangladesh Bank (Central Bank of Bangladesh), 1998-2001, Member, Board of

Trustees, BIDS, Member, Council of Economic Advisors, Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh. The report of the 8th Pay and Services Commission chaired by Dr. Mohammed Farashuddin provides a comprehensively effective scheme for transforming the civil servants into human resources for major contributions towards building a prosperous Bangladesh.

Dr. Mohammed Farashuddin was the Founder Vice Chancellor, East West University, Dhaka, February 1996- November 1998, Founder President, Board of Directors, East West University, 1995-1998, Chairman, Sonali Bank, 1998, Chairman, Palli Karma-Sahayak Foundation (PKSF), apex body for providing micro-credit for poverty alleviation August 1996- August 1998, Chairman, Bangladesh Shilpa Reen Sangstha (Industrial Credit Bank)- 1996, Member, National Education Committee 1997, Resident Representative and Resident Representative a.i. of UNDP in three countries 1985-1995, Controller of Capital Issues, Government of the Peoples Republic of Bangladesh, August 1983- January 1985, Director, Board of Directors, Agrani Bank; Investment Corporation of Bangladesh; British American Tobacco Company; Film Censor Board; National Tea Company; Sadharon Bima Corporation 1979-1985 etc.

As the Governor of Bangladesh Bank Dr. Mohammed Farashuddin introduced major reforms towards a healthy, sound, transparent and minimum default banking system. As the Controller of Capital Issues in the Ministry of Finance, Dr Mohammed Farashuddin helped create a new look and potentially vigorous Capital Market. He also assisted the opening of the banking and insurance to the private sector. Dr. Farashuddin made the initial draft for the Grameen Bank Ordinance, 1983 under the guidence of Mr. M. Syeduzzaman the then Principal Secretary of the Ministry of Finance.







As Rapporteur of the UNDP Governing Council, Dr. Mohammed Farashuddin was required to play in 1980 a key role in the ongoing resource mobilization efforts of the organization.

As an important member of the Bangladesh Delegation to the First UNLDC Conference held in Paris in 1981, Dr. Mohammed Farashuddin played an active role in the formulation of the Substantial new Programme of Action.

As decided in the First UNLDC Conference in 1981, Dr. Mohammed Farashuddin was appointed a UN Consultant to study and compile a report on the Aid Modalities in the Least Developed countries of the Asia Pacific.

Dr. Farashuddin organized two donor meetings in Vienna for the Republic of Maldives in 1993 and 1995. His leadership role as the UNDP Resident Representative and UN Resident Coordinator of Maldives in the formulation of the Country Reports as well as present action in the Vienna Meetings subsequently helped Maldives graduate out of the LDC category.

He was the Private Secretary of the Prime Minister and the President of Bangladesh (Founding Father) 1973 – 1975. Mr. Farashuddin assisted the Father of the Nation in shaping the socio-economic-cultural policy as well as the poverty eradication thrust. He accompanied Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman to his visit to key international organization, the United Nations in 1974, the Commonwealth Heads of Government Meeting in Jamaica in 1974 and to many country visits like to India, USA, USSR, UK, UAE and Iraq. He had the privilege of coming into contact with great leaders such as President Breznev, President Tito, President Soekarona, Prime Minister Indira Gandhi, Prime Minister Whitlam, Prime Minister Wilson, Senator Kennedy and so on.

Dr. Mohammed Farashuddin is a Member, Board of Trustees, Bangladesh Institute of Development Studies, Senior Fellow, Bangladesh Institute of Development Studies; Life Member, Bangladesh Economic Association; Life Member, Diabetic Association of Bangladesh; President, Dhaka University Economics Department Alumni Association; Permanent Member, Officers Club.

Dr. Farashuddin did his BA Honors and MA in Economics from University of Dhaka. MA (Econ), MA (Political Economy) and Ph.D as an outstanding foreign student from Boston University USA and a certificate course in Project Planning from Project Planning Centre Bradford University, UK. Dr. Farashuddin's contribution as the Founder Vice Chancellor of East West University (now Chief Adviser of the Board of Trustees) is widely recognized as the foundation for a credibly transparent and efficient apparatus for tertiary education by the Private Universities which now account for 63% of total university student enrolment.

Dr. Mohammed Farashuddin has been honored with various awards home and abroad in recognition of his contribution in economics, higher education, banking and public service. He has a good number of publications to his credit. Dr. Mohammed Farashuddin was recognized as outstanding leader of Higher Education in Bangladesh.

Mohammed Farashuddin was born on April 18, 1942 to a middle class and enlightened muslim family in Ratanpur village of Madhabpur thana in Habiganj District. He is particularly fond of rural Bangladesh and works for the realization of the dream of a Sonar Bangla free of poverty, illiteracy, shelterlessness and disparity in income and opportunities.

Married for 50 years with Suraiya Farashuddin, Mr. Farashuddin is the proud father of one son and one daughter. They have 4 grandchildren, one sweet daughter-in-law, mamoni and a wonderful son-in-law, baba.

Club Activity Report for RY 2022-23


A comprehensive Activity Report for RY2022-23 of the Rotary Club of Dhaka Mega City is given below.

- Introduction: It is with great pride that we recount the remarkable journey we embarked on during this eventful year. Rotary Club of Dhaka Mega City, a proud member of Rotary International District 3281 in Bangladesh, completed RY 22-23 with unwavering dedication and notable achievements. This year was characterized by extensive service projects, active member participation, and a strong sense of fellowship.
- Service Projects and Rotary's Seven Focus Areas: In line with Rotary's commitment to service, our club accomplished a remarkable feat by initiating 222 projects in RY22-23 worth BDT 71,66,590/- spanning all seven of Rotary's focus areas of which 220 projects were successfully completed fully worth BDT 52,06,590/-. Implementation of two (02) projects appx. BDT 19,60,000/- is in-progress. In addition to these 222 projects, club participated in another 32 projects jointly with different other clubs.
- 1. Water and Sanitation (6 Projects): We have donated total ten tube wells, renovated one public toilet, and maintained two comfort centers built by the club in earlier years.



2. Economic and Community Development (112 Projects): Our club actively engaged with the community by organizing projects with tangible and positive impact on countless lives. We initiated projects that promoted entrepreneurship and supported small businesses in our community. We put highest focus on income generating projects so that beneficiaries of the projects can earn their own bread and butter and become solvent. We have provided small business capital, donated 10 vans/rickshaws, 5 dairy cows, 45+ goats etc. during the year.

Mega City implemented 'sustainable irrigation project' in the second half of RY22-23 where irrigation facility was created for 70 farmers covering 50 acres of land. Farmers will run this independently in future years. District Governor Nominee, RID 3283, Mohammad Shahidul Bari formally inaugurated the project.

Sadek Jobeda RCC Center at Taluknagar: RCDMC took an initiative to develop an RCC center at RCC village Taluknagar Manikgonj. The center will be constructed gradually over the next few years. Foundation stone of the center was laid in RY22-23 by District Governor Nominee, RID 3283, Mohammad Shahidul Bari. RCC center will consist of (a) A Community Clinic (b) Library (c) Recreation Center cum Indoor Games (d) RCC Center Office etc. Rtn PP Abdus Salm Khan donated the land for RCC Center. Funds will be raised gradually for this project.

RCDMC also took an initiative to reconstruct the Taluknagar High School Masjid upon request from the School Managing Committee at an estimated cost of Taka Thirty-Five Lacs.

- 3. Maternal & Child Health (18 Projects): The Club supported 'Sonamoni Nibash, an Abandoned Children Home at Azimpur Dhaka under the Ministry of Social Welfare GoB since 2018. During RY22-23, we provided monthly salary for nursing staff for the infants, provided food, milk-powder, diaper, toys etc. for the kids round the year.
- 4. Supporting the Environment (12 Projects): dedication to environmental sustainability was evident through treeplanting initiatives, clean-up drives, releasing cage birds to nature, and advocacy for eco-friendly agriculture, contributing to a cleaner and greener country etc.
- 5. Basic Education and Literacy (31 projects): We continued our steadfast support for education, ensuring that underprivileged students have access to quality education. This included supporting underprivileged children's education by providing SSC exam fees/tuition fees, donating books for students/libraries, sponsoring scholarships, supplying essential school materials etc. We have donated 30 Laptops at different schools at Lakshmipur, Dhaka and Manikganj. 'Siemens Energy Bangladesh' donated the laptops, whereas Dhaka Mega City identified the requirement and supported execution of the project.

- 6. Disease Prevention and Treatment (41 Projects): We provided healthcare access to marginalized communities via emergency financial support for treatment & disease prevention, facilitate surgery, financial assistance to elderly persons and physically challenged children for medicine, distributed wheelchairs, diabetic test camp, raised awareness about critical health issues within our community. Collaborating with local institutions allowed us to provide muchneeded medical services to those in need.
- 7. Peace and Conflict Resolution (2 Projects): Through peace-building initiatives and dialogues, we worked diligently to foster understanding and resolve conflicts at RCC village, contributing to a more harmonious society.





CHALLENGES TO IMPROVE FINANCIAL SUSTAINABILITY IN A NOT-FOR-PROFIT ORGANISATION

The project budget is prepared based on the project activities outlined in the project log frame. Subsequently, an organizational budget is created, taking into account the projected funds, expected to be received during a specific period. Within these project funds, organizational expenditures, including salary payments to regular staff, are incurred.

However, in certain cases, project-planned activities such as surveys, data collection, dialogues, and publications may not be executed in a timely manner, resulting in delays in delivering relevant deliverables and no corresponding expenditures. Consequently, the financial spending of project funds appears unsatisfactory.

Furthermore, the costs associated with project activities, such as surveys, data collection, consultant payments, equipment purchases, dialogues, and publications are continually increasing. The cost will also be higher due to inflation. Therefore, the project will not economically viable.

To ensure the delivery of high-quality outputs, the organization requires highly skilled human resources. However, attracting and retaining top talent can be challenging due to competition from academia, industry, and other research organizations. Therefore, additional financial resources are necessary to provide competitive salaries and benefits, enabling the organization to attract and retain talented individuals.

Additionally, the organization incurs regular expenses such as staff salaries, administrative costs, and other necessary expenditures to ensure the smooth functioning of the organization. Despite these expenditures, no additional outputs are received, resulting in no additional funding being received from donors or partners. As a result, new funds are required to cover staff salaries and execute project activities that were not initially budgeted. This presents a challenge to the organization's long-term sustainability.

Improving financial sustainability in the above-mentioned scenario would require addressing several challenges. Here are some of the steps that need to be taken:

1. **Effective project planning:** Enhance the accuracy of project planning by ensuring that activities are realistically scheduled and adequate resources are allocated. This will help in minimizing delays and ensuring timely execution of project deliverables.







- **2. Activity monitoring and implementation:** Implement a robust monitoring and evaluation system to track project activities and progress. Regularly review the project's status and take necessary actions to address any delays or issues that may arise.
- **3. Budget reallocation and re-prioritization:** If certain planned activities cannot be executed within the allocated timeframe, consider reallocating the funds to other high-priority activities that can be completed on time. This will ensure that the project continues to progress and funds are utilized effectively.
- **4. Efficient financial management:** Improve financial management practices within the organization to ensure that expenditures are closely monitored and controlled. Implement measures to reduce unnecessary expenses and optimize resource allocation.
- **5. Diversify funding sources:** Overreliance on a single donor or funding partner can increase the vulnerability of an organization. Explore opportunities to diversify funding sources by seeking support from multiple donors, applying for grants, or engaging in fundraising activities. This will reduce dependence on a single funding stream and provide a more stable financial base.
- **6. Build partnerships and collaborations:** Establish partnerships and collaborations with other organizations or institutions that share similar objectives. Collaborative projects can leverage resources, share costs, and enhance the overall financial sustainability of all involved parties.
- **7. Develop income-generating activities:** Explore the possibility of developing income-generating activities that align with the organization's mission and activities. This could include offering training or consulting services, organizing events or conferences, or creating products or services that generate revenue.
- **8. Strengthen donor relationships:** Maintain open and transparent communication with donors and funding partners. Regularly update them on project progress, challenges faced, and mitigation strategies. Building strong relationships with donors can increase their trust in the organization and potentially lead to additional support.
- **9. Long-term financial planning:** Develop a long-term financial plan that takes into account both project-specific funding needs and the organization's operational costs. This plan should include provisions for unforeseen delays or changes in project timelines and ensure that sufficient funds are allocated for salary payments and administrative expenses.
- **10. Capacity building:** Invest in building the capacity of staff and key stakeholders in financial management, fundraising, and proposal writing. Strengthening these skills will enhance the organization's ability to secure funding and effectively manage resources.

By implementing these measures, an organization can improve its financial sustainability, mitigate challenges arising from delays in project execution, and ensure its long-term viability.
